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TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE TVET AND UNIVERSITY WORK INTEGRATED LEARNING TRACK AND TRACER STUDY 2024/25

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1. BACKGROUND & CONTEXT

The Health and Welfare Sector Education Training Authority (HWSETA) facilitates skills development in the Health and Welfare sectors. HWSETA, as mandated by the Skills Development Act no 97 of 1998, is responsible for funding and facilitating education, training and skills development interventions to the workforce of the Health and Welfare development sectors. The ultimate goal of these interventions is to close the skills gap in the Health and Welfare sector by increasing employability for the unemployed and career progression for those already employed. Furthermore, the HWSETA carries a responsibility of evaluating the outcome of the education, training, and skills development interventions. To this end, the HWSETA has been conducting the track and tracer study to asses learner pathways upon completion of their programmes. The track and trace study is conducted annually through telephonic survey by an external service provider. We are currently calling for a capable service provider with experience in data collection for research purposes using Computer Assisted Telephonic interviews (CATI) surveys to conduct the telephonic survey for 2023/24.

2. RATIONALE AND PURPOSE

A request for proposals from service providers to conduct a telephonic survey on tracking and tracing learners in the following SETA-funded learning programmes:

- TVET Work Integrated Learning
- University Work Integrated Learning

The project will serve to understand, explore and document key features, trends, challenges and outcomes of skills interventions in the Health and Welfare sectors. Fundamentally, the research project will assist in further developing a sustainable skills development strategy for the HWSETA. This would contribute positively to the HWSETA sectors and promote inclusive economic growth in the country.

This study seeks to understand the outcomes of work integrated learning for students at TVET colleges and universities by tracking and tracing learners within the health and welfare sector. The purpose of this assignment is to provide SETA with information about the qualification attained by TVET and university WIL learners who completed WIL programmes. Tracer studies are designed to determine whether a programme is achieving its mission and assist in demonstrating the programme's outcomes.



3. GOAL

The goal of this study is to assess the effectiveness of the Work integrated Learning (WIL) programme funded by HWSETA targeting TVET and University students.

The aim of this study therefore is to measure the extent to which **unemployed TVET College students and university students obtain qualifications** after successfully completing the Work Integrated Learning programmes funded by the HWSETA

4. OBJECTIVES

The study should, therefore, address the following related objectives:

- 1. To determine attainment of full qualification after completion of the WIL programme.
- 2. To determine learners' experiences towards the WIL programme.
- 3. To determine learners' perception towards the WIL programme.
- 4. To determine learner employability after completion of WIL programme.

5. SPECIFIC RESEARCH QUESTIONS

The research study seeks to answer the following specific questions:

- 1. Have the WIL learners obtained a full qualification upon completion of WIL programme?
- 2. What are the learners' perspectives on the influence of WIL in enhancing their competencies (knowledge, skills, and abilities)?
- 3. What is the learners' work-readiness after completing the WIL programme?
- 4. After completing the WIL program and obtaining their qualifications, did the learners acquire employment?

6. SCOPE OF WORK

The service provider will be required to:

 Conduct an evaluation research study by tracking and tracing learners who have completed HWSETA-funded TVET and University WIL through telephonic interviews.



- Programme or script a questionnaire already designed by HWSETA on CATI software.
 This software should have the capability of capturing data as it is collected.
- Conducting telephonic interviews based on a scripted questionnaire with a specified sample of learners who have undergone and completed TVET and University WIL programme. A comprehensive database containing a sample of approximately 545 learners who completed TVET and University WIL programmes from the HWSETA's learner population of 2023/24 financial year will be provided.
- Follow the sampling guidelines provided by the SETA to ensure a stratified random sample of completers.
- Deliver a database from the interviews and scripted questionnaires using the tools and templates provided by the HWSETA
- Provide labelled Audio's for each learner contacted; this should include both the successful and unsuccessful interviews.
- Produce a track and trace technical/fieldwork report based on a template provided by the HWSETA.
- Conduct data analysis based on the analytical framework provided by the HWSETA.
- Prepare and submit an evaluation report against key outcome indicators using a template provided by the SETA.

7. COSTING

There will be one questionnaire with different sample sizes, please provide a cost indication separately for each.
